INTIMATE TRUTH QUESTIONS (THE "TRUTH" CATEGORY)

- **Fantasy**
Focused: "What is one place you have always wanted to make love?" or "Is there a specific role-play scenario you find

- **Preference**
Probes: "Do you prefer slow and sensual or fast and rough?" or "What is your favorite part of my body and why?"
- **History and Experience:**

- **Boundary Breakers:** "Is there something you want to try but are too nervous to ask for?" or "What is something you think we don't do enough of?"

SEDUCTIVE DARE ACTIONS (THE "DARE" CATEGORY)

- **Sensual Touch:**

"Give your partner a massage using scented oil, focusing only on their shoulders and arms." or "Trace the outline of your partner's lips with your finger for 30 seconds without speaking."

- **Temperature**

Play: "Hold an ice cube in your mouth and then kiss your partner's chest or stomach." or "Use a warm spoon to gently trace down your partner's spine."

- **Blindfold**

Basics: "Let

your partner blindfold you for five minutes and do whatever they want with a feather." or "Be blindfolded and guess what object your partner is using to touch you (e.g., a silk scarf, a leather belt, a feather)."
